Tasks

You will take care of the children on a daily basis (changing diapers, helping with meals, sleeping, etc.). Each day you will set up and lead fun, educational, and developmentally appropriate activities for children, in line with the educational project and the values of the structure.

Your job will also include:

- working closely with a multicultural,

bilingual (French/English) team, including various early childhood experts and guests.

- Maintaining a caring communication at all times with children, colleagues, and parents.
- Respecting the values of our educational project, based on encouraging the child's autonomy (see more at www.givingtree.fr).
